Carmyn James - Head Coach - Women’s Track & Field Program & Cross Country– University of Hawai’i - Coach Carmyn in her 13th season as Head Coach of the Women’s Track & Field Program will report on her upcoming trip to Seattle for the University of Washington Indoor Preview on January 12th. She’ll give us an update on her staff and team for the 2013 season. Coach will review her additions to the team for this year and who to watch as the season progresses. Coach Carmyn will introduce a new member of her coaching staff, *Robert Weir*.

Robert Weir – Assistant Coach – Throws –University of Hawai’i – Coach Robert comes from the University of Oregon where he coach both men and women throwers having a highly decorated program. In 2012, the University of Oregon, won it’s 4th. consecutive women’s Pac 12 title. Prior the Oregon, he spent a year at the University of Kentucky after 16 years at Stanford University as an assistant coach and head coach. Coach Robert is a 12-time Great Britain national champion in the discus and was a member of that country’s World Championship Team. He has had extensive experience on the international level coaching throws for Team USA. The Honolulu Quarterback Club welcomes Coach Robert Weir, Assistant Coach.
