Mike Brown - Head Diving Coach - The season will mark Coach Mike's 32nd year in coaching college diving and he and his wife, Assistant Diving Coach, Anita Rossingis are entering her 14th year coaching at UH. The Hawai'i Diving Invitational competition at the Duke Kahanamoku Aquatic Complex concluded this weekend and Amund Gismervik, sophomore, from UH, won the men's 3-meter, platform events and the 1-meter competition. Aimee Harrison, UH sophomore, won the 1-meter 3-meter title in the tournament. Lauren Hall took second place just behind Aimee in the 1-meter and was only 7 points behind. Next, the swimming and diving teams will compete in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Championships in February. Listen to the inside stories to the success of these divers Monday.

Summer Harrison - Swimmer - Mid Pacific Institute (MidPac) - Summer broke the record at the Kalani Invitational and was selected as Hawai'i Most Valuable Swimmer. She is the 2x State 100 yard Freestyle Champion and broke the record after 32 years. Summer is a All-Time State Record Holder in the 100 yard Butterfly.
