Both coaches will be talking about diving at the Wally Nakamoto Invitational, and diving events against Minnesota and Drury, held so far in January. UH won **the top three spots in the women's platform. Senior Madison Sthamann won, followed by Mariah Renteria and Ivy Houser.** Recently, divers Madison Sthamann and Johan Sandell were selected the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Athlete of the Week honors. Madison posted a career-best in the **women's platform finals at the UCLA ruins Diving Invitational. She is the reigning** female MPSF diver of the year. Johan Sandell, a junior from Sweden placed second in the 1 meter and 3 meter events and was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the platform event. This is the second time Johan received athlete of the week. Johan is also the male reigning MPSF diver of the year. Coaches Mike and Anita will take questions HQC members and guests.
