+ Maureen "Mo" Flanagan Cole - Head Coach - Wahine Water Polo - UH

+ Quinn Fisher - Pacific Roller Derby

Maureen "Mo" Flanagan Cole – Head Coach – Women's Water Polo – University of Hawai'i – The team had a 6-1 record and overall 18-9 record, ranking them 6th in the 2013 Collegiate Water Polo Association. The Coach "Mo" was named head coach in 2011 and this is her third visit to the HQC. Previously, she was the UH water polo's assistant coach for 5 years. Coach "Mo" is the 5th coach in 14 years of water polo at UH. During her 5 years as assistant coach at UH, the team had been a contender in the MPSF by scoring 92 victories and placing 3rd in the conference finishes of 2010 and 2012. In 2013, she was named Big West Coach of the Year. Coach "Mo" will talk about the upcoming season, the team members and who to look out for this year.

Quinn Fisher - Pacific Roller Derby - In 2008, Pacific Roller Derby (Pacific) brought back the excitement of roller derby back to Honolulu, Hawaii. The all female flat-track roller derby league has shown fans what it means to push one's self to their highest potential and form a strong community around one of the world's fastest growing female dominated sports. As members of this league we continue to keep the enthusiasm alive and spread the derby love. In 2009, Pacific became a member of the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA). Pacific is currently ranked 24 out of 38 in the WFTDA international-based Western division. WFTDA promotes and fosters the sport of women's flat-track derby by developing athletic ability, sportswomanship, and goodwill among member leagues. Pacific is excited to learn about local sponsorship opportunities and about local venues to call home for their on-skates events so they may continue to spread roller derby's popularity around the island. Skaters with Pacific Roller Derby will gear up on Saturday, February 15 at 4 p.m. for the first bout of the 2014 roller derby home season at the U.S. Coast Guard Hideaway Club. The **South Shore**

Sirens take on Pacific's newest home team, the **Tropic Thunder**. Each team will debut five newly drafted skaters. Don't miss this hour long-bout as these athletes give each other hip checks and whips on the recently refinished flat-track for the first win of the season. Quinn will talk about this season.
