Charles (Kale) Ane III - Associate Athletic Director - Head Football Coach - Punahou - The "Buffanblu" ended their 2012 season with a 2nd place finish in the Hawai'i High School Athletic Association Division I State Championship Game. Coach Kale will review the 2012 Football Season and talk about his "key" players and returnees for next season. In addition, he will talk about injury prevention in high school sports. Punahou, noted for top athletics programs, have been selected as the No. 1 program on several occasions by Sports Illustrated. Student body participation in sports at Punahou is over 70% within grades 7 through 12.

Michele Nagamine – Head Coach – Wahine Soccer – University of Hawai'i. - Coach "Bud" is entering her 3rd. season as Head Coach for the Wahine Soccer Program. Before taking on the Head Coaching job at UH, she was the head women's soccer coach at HPU where she directed the program into a conference contender. Coach Michele was also one of the most successful coaches in high school athletics. Under her coaching, at Kamehameha, her teams won 5 state championships and 6 ILH titles. For the 2013 Season, Coach Michele is working on her 2013 new player commitments. She will give us a run-down on all her recruits and returnees for the upcoming collegiate season on Monday at the Quarterback Club luncheon.
