Chris Tanaka – Sports Director – Hawai'i News Now - This is the first visit to the HQC for newly appointed Sports Director, Chris Tanaka of Hawai'i News Now. Chris calls himself a "workaholic", since he can work from his home, from a coffee shop, from a parked car, airport or restaurant. To Chris, a workaholic clearly means sports fan. Before joining KGMB-TV, KHNL-TV and KFVE-TV, Chris worked his way up to lead sports anchor at KDVR-TV and KWGN-TV, which also were merged television stations in Denver. He also worked as sports director at KFBB-TV in Great Falls, Mont., and for the Fox Sports Network in Los Angeles. He enjoys running, surfing, golfing of just hanging out on the beach. The HQC will welcome Chris at Monday's luncheon.

Thomas Schubert – Professional Tennis Player – Thomas, a former Punahou elementary and grade school student, attended high school at a tennis academy on the mainland. From there, he went on to finish his collegiate career at BYU, where he played and achieved the ranking of #1 in Singles and #2 in Doubles. He also had a high ranking in the NCAA in both Singles and Doubles. After graduation, he qualified as a touring professional and writer for 10sballs.com. At the beginning of his tennis career, he won his first few matches earning him a world rank of 1513 and he has steadily improved that ranking. In the Kailua Night Doubles, held recently, Thomas and his partner Ikaika Jobe finished #2 which is impressive since this was the first time he and his partner entered the event. Thomas travels on the USTA Pro Circuit Challenger Championship Series as an assistant and media manager. We welcome Thomas since this is also his first luncheon visit to the Honolulu Quarterback Club.
