**Lori McCarney is the CEO of Bikeshare Hawaii**, a local non-profit that will be bringing a major bikeshare system to Hawaii. She is an active member of the community with nearly 40 years experience in marketing, advertising and business leadership. She is also an accomplished triathlete, competing in 10 Ironman Triathlons, most recently the World Championship in Kona in 2014. Recently, she was the SVP of Operations at Coldwell Banker Pacific Properties. Bank of Hawaii recruited her to Hawaii in 1999 as a Group Executive Vice President. Prior to making Hawaii home, Lori led the marketing of Bank of America and then Wells Fargo across all of their national and international markets. She gained major advertising experience at McCann Erickson and Grey advertising from working on national and international brands including Exxon, Nabisco, Unilever and Gillette. Community service is important to Lori. She is Immediate Past Chairman of the Blood Bank of Hawaii Board, Past President of the Board of JDRF, Communications Chair for Kapiolani Health Foundation's Board and on the Board of Move Oahu Forward. **Bob Barry - USATF Masters Discus Thrower - Three Time All-American – Retired 'Iolani boys soccer coach** - Bob has been involved in Discus Throwing from 2011 to present and over that period of time he scored four 1<sup>st</sup>, two 2<sup>nd</sup>, one 3<sup>rd</sup>, two 5<sup>th</sup>, and one 8<sup>th</sup> place finishes. His personal best is 35.40 meters and he was selected as an All-American in 1973, 1974, and 1975. In 2015, Bob was rank 5<sup>th</sup> in the USA Masters Rankings and 18<sup>th</sup> in the World Masters Rankings. In 2016, he will be participating in The Masters Classic and National Senior Games. Bob is a member of the Hawaii Masters Track Club, the Texas Throwers Club and was on the staff of the Ironwood Throws Camp Spokane, Washington in 2014 and currently in 2016. In 2004, he became a member of the NSCAA State Technical Soccer as a Coordinator for Hawai'i and has held several coaching and director positions in both high school and college. He served as Head Boys' Soccer Coach at 'Iolani from 1970 to 1996 and had a winning record of 328-116-46. During this period, he was named Hawai'i High School Coach of the Year 5 times, named NSCAA Regional Coach of the Year and his teams won the Hawai'i State Championships 5 times and state runner up 5 times. Coach Bob will entertain questions from luncheon attendees on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Club.
