The Honolulu Quarterback Club, celebrating 66 Years, is pleased to announce the following Guest Speakers for their luncheon, Monday, February 27th., at the MGR:

+ Dana Takahara-Dias – Head Coach – Wahine Basketball – University of Hawai'i
+ Michele Nagamine – Head Coach – Wahine Soccer – University of Hawai'i

Dana Takahara - Dias - Head Coach - Wahine Basketball - University of Hawai'i – Coach Dana will be entering her third year as Head Coach of the Wahine Basketball Program. The Wahine are currently 10-15 overall and 5-5 in the WAC which ranks them in 4th place. The final game of the season was against Fresno State who was ranked 1st. place in the WAC and Coach Dana will give us all the details on Monday. Currently, sophomore Kamilah Jackson continues to be the backbone of the team. Overall, she leads UH with 13.3 points per game and 10.6 rebounds per game. Vicky Tagalicod, sophomore, who was a transfer to UH, is second on the Wahine team averaging 10.6 points per game with 5.4 rebounds. Coach Dana will talk about the season, the players and what holds for the future on Monday at the Quarterback Luncheon. Coach Dana will entertain questions.

Michele Nagamine – Head Coach – Wahine Soccer – University of Hawai'i. - Coach Michele is entering her 2nd season as Head Coach for the Wahine Soccer Program. Before taking on the Head Coaching job at UH, she was the head women's soccer coach at HPU where she directed the program into a conference contender. Coach Michele was also one of the most successful coaches in high school athletics. Under her coaching, at Kamehameha, her teams won 5 state championships and 6 ILH titles. For the 2012 Season, Coach Michele has received commitments from 9 new players. One player from this group is local while the other 8 are from the California area. UH had a 5-12-1 overall record last season and finished tied for 3rd place with a record of 4-2-1 in the WAC. She will give us a run-down on all her recruits and the upcoming collegiate season on Monday at the Quarterback Club luncheon.
