**Dr. Carole Spangler Vaughn - Ph.D. - Sports Stem Cell Therapy - Medivet-America** Dr. Vaughn holds a Ph.D. in Biophysics from The Johns Hopkins University and an MBA from the University of Washington. She has held a variety of positions in the biopharma/healthcare industry, working for large and small companies, both in the laboratory and in business development. She spent several years as a laboratory manager at Bristol-Myers Squibb, in their biologics discovery unit. She worked at the University of Washington’s Office of Technology Transfer, where she evaluated and out-licensed technologies. She was Director of Business Development at Dendreon Corporation, VP of Business Development for Clario Medical Imaging, and has consulted and advised several healthcare-related emerging companies, focusing on strategy, fund-raising, sales, and marketing. She currently is the healthcare strategic advisor for Rockwood Capital Partners, a boutique early-stage investment firm, and owns and operates the Hawaii State franchise for MediVet-America, the world’s largest veterinarian stem cell therapy company. Dr. Vaughn will talk on "Stem Cell Therapy’s Impact on Sports Medicine, What We Know and What We Don’t Know" on Monday.
