This season will mark Coach Mike's 37th year coaching college diving and he and his wife, Assistant Diving Coach Anita, are entering their 19th year coaching at UH. Both coaches will be speaking about the diving competition at the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Conference Championships held in Mission Viejo California. UH men and women divers won all six individual diving titles. Johan Sandell secured first place in the platform dive and was 100 points over his teammate Octavio Lucero. In women's diving, Victoria Moretti won the platform dive. The performance of the diving team contributed to helping the UH men's and women's swimming and diving teams win the MPSF Conference Championships. The women won their third straight championship and the men won their first. Both Coaches will entertain questions from HQC members and guests on Monday.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available.
