Wes Nakama – Assistant Director of Information – Hawaii High School Athletic Association – Wes will give us an update on all the spring high school sports and any changes from recent meetings held at the HHSAA. Also, Wes is a reporter for scoringlive.com., a website that is available to the general public which reports the latest scores for almost all high school games in the state. Coach Scott has been selected as Head Coach and he is also associate coach with the indoor Rainbow Wahine. He played on the US national beach volleyball team and had a very successful volleyball career before he entered the coaching ranks. He was an outstanding player at Punahou in both volleyball and basketball and received all-state honors during his high school days. The inaugural season will begin with a tournament against HPU and Nittaidai of Japan at the Queen's Beach Sand Box in Waikiki. Coach Scott will talk about this new sport at UH, the players and the schedule on Monday at the HQC luncheon.
