+ Ralph Steensen – Historian – History of Harry M. Field

Ralph Steensen – Historian – History of Harry M. Field – **Ralph's uncle**, the late State Senator Harry M. Field, played professional football for the then NFL Chicago Cardinals in 1934. He was an NFL all-pro offensive and defensive linemen in 1935, 1936 and 1937 and was an all-Pac 8 lineman at Oregon State in 1932, 1933, and 1934. He played one year at UH under coach Otto Klum and lettered in football. Senator Field attended Punahou and was an all-ILH running back and defensive lineman in 1928, 1929, and 1930. In 1980, he was inducted into the inaugural Men Of [O] sports hall of fame at Punahou. Senator Harry returned to Honolulu in 1940 and was head football Coach at Punahou off and on until 1951. Senator Harry's mother Margaret Nape was a full-blooded Hawaiian and a direct descendant of the last King of Maui. Our speaker, Ralph is the son of his hanai sister Dorothy Field and was raised by his oldest sister Edith Field. Ralph is a 1963 graduate of Roosevelt and UH and also retired from The State of Hawai'i. He has been a member of the Quarterback Club from 1960 to 1990 **and joined again 3 year's ago**. He has been trying to have his uncle considered for induction into The Polynesian Football Hall Of Fame.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon.
