**Carmyn James - Head Coach - Wahine Track & Field – University of Hawaii -**

The last time Coach Carmyn visited the HQC was last December. She and the team just returned from the WAC Indoor Championships, which were held in Nampa Idaho. **Amber Kaufman** successfully defended her high jump-title. She cleared 6 ft. to capture her 4th career gold medal. **Sarah Saddleton**, a sophomore, cleared the bar at 5 ft. 8 in. to take 2nd place. The "Wahine" ended up in 5th place. The next indoor event will be in March in Fayetteville, Ark. Coach Carmyn will give us her take on the team this year.

**Ronn Miyashiro - Head Coach - Men's Golf Team - University of Hawaii -**

It was April, 2008 when Coach Ronn last appeared at the HQC. This year, Coach is entering his 12th season as Head Coach of the team and he has been the coach since 1988. The team just finished the John A. Burns Intercollegiate in February and secured 13th place. The top finisher was freshman **Cory Oride** who lead the team a second time in a UH Tournament. Participating this year were sophomore, **T.J. Kua**, junior **Kamden Brakel**, sophomore, **Jared Sawada** and sophomore **Pono Calip**. There were 15 teams this year that competed in the 3 day tournament. The tournament is in it's 34th year and is considered the UH premiere golf tournament.
