+ Michele "Bud" Nagamine - Head Coach - Wahine Soccer - UH

+ Sergio Bolioli - Head Coach - Major Island Soccer Organization

Michele "Bud" Nagamine - Head Coach - Wahine Soccer - University of Hawaii - Coach Bud enters her 4th season as head coach. Last season, Coach Bud and her team went 8-8 including 3-4-1 in the Big West in the 2013 season. She is busy putting together her team for the 2014 season and has recruited 2 local players along with 3 other freshman who are the incoming players for the upcoming season. Coach Bud is familiar with both of these local players, Sonest Furtado of Waianae and Kiani Halushka of Kamehameha from the local community and has watched them grow and develop. On the defensive side, she has lost 3 out of the 4 players to graduation. She thinks that she found the player for her center back on the mainland and hopes she will fit-in with the other players. Coach Bud will talk about the upcoming season and her players.

Sergio Bolioli - Head Coach - Major Island Soccer Organization - Coach Sergio originally from Uruguay, came to Hawai'i to visit his brother and planned to stay for 6 months, but, never left for the next 28 years. In Uruguay, soccer (futbol) ran through his blood since soccer is a big part of the culture. Upon his arrival, he began to look for a place where soccer was being played and found pickup games at Kapiolani Park. After a very short period of time, Coach Sergio was invited and recruited to play on a League team. After a few years, he recognized that Hawai'i needed more organized soccer and after several discussions with players, MISO was born. The League went through growth problems and in August of 1997, Coach Sergio took control and the League began to grow. He made MISO a full time commitment and that lead to the current success of the League. Coach Sergio will talk about the MISO and explain the different divisions which are currently established here and he will look into the future for the MISO on Monday.
