**+ Chris Naeole - Offensive Line Coach - Warriors Football - University of Hawai'i**  
**+ Mike Brown - Head Diving Coach - University of Hawai'i**

**Chris Naeole - Offensive Line Coach - Warriors Football - University of Hawai'i** - Last month, Head Football Coach, Norm Chow, named Chris Naeole as the new Offensive Line Coach for the University of Hawai'i Football Warriors. Coach Chris is a graduate of Kahuku High School, and grew up on Oahu's north shore. He attended college in Colorado and he played on the offensive line. He was a 3 year starter and was selected an All-American in his senior year. During his college career, he had only allowed 1 sack charged against him and was a 2-time first-team all-Big 12 pick. After college, he was drafted by New Orleans and was the 10th overall pick in the NFL Draft. He spent 11 years in the NFL playing for the Saints and the Jacksonville Jaguars. During his career in professional football, he only missed 1 game due to injury and started in 150 out of 154 games. Following his professional football playing career, he began his coaching career as a defensive line coach at Iolani School for 3 years. The Honolulu Quarterback Club welcomes Coach Chris.

**Mike Brown - Head Diving Coach - University of Hawai'i** - This season will mark Coach Mike's 31th year in coaching college diving and he will be entering his 13th year of coaching at UH. Divers at UH have won 2 individual NCAA diving titles in 2005 and 2008. While at UH, Coach Mike has been named WAC Diving Coach of the year 7 times. Coach Mike will talk about freshman, Amund Gismerbik, who was a member of the Norwegian Olympic team and now diving for the University of Hawai'i, and the upcoming NCAA Zone E Diving Championships.
