+ Tommy Lee - Offensive Coordinator - Football Warriors - University of Hawai'i

Tommy Lee – Offensive Coordinator - Football Warriors – University of Hawai'i – Coach Tommy has been coaching for over 40 years and has been appointed quarterbacks and wider receivers coach. He came to UH from Montana West where he held the position of Head Coach. During the 2002 and 2004 season, the team ended up co-champions of the Frontier conference. In his final season as head coach, the team finished leading the conference in total defense and passing. Before Montana West, Coach Tommy was at Utah and led the WAC in total offense and was 2nd in scoring offense. The team finished with a national ranking of 18th in rushing offense and had averaged 200 yards per game. Before his 2nd time in collegiate coaching, Coach Tommy spent 4 seasons in professional football and was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for Toronto in the Canadian Football League and coached in the same capacity for San Antonio of the World League of American Football. Previous to that he coached at Montana where he too was very successful. Coach Lee will give us a run-down on the 21 new recruits, their history and who he picks will become familiar names next season..
