The Honolulu Quarterback Club, celebrating 64 Years, is pleased to announce the following Guest Speakers for their luncheon, Monday, March 15th., at the Maple Garden Restaurant. The Maple Garden is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch begins at 11:30 AM and the program begins at 12 noon:

Victor Wales - Head Coach - Men's & Women's Swimming – University of Hawaii - In his fourth year steering the men and women's swimming program, Coach Victor has filled his needs for talent on both swim teams. Last year as a result of recruiting 24/7, he ended the season with the men's team finishing in second place in the Conference USA and the women's team finished third in the WAC Championships. In early March, UH Swimmer Luca Mazzurana in the Conference USA Invitational Championships was named Swimmer of the Meet and Coach Victor was named Coach of the Meet. Coach will be returning from the NCAA Zone Meet held on the mainland this upcoming weekend and will discuss the results along with all the inside stories of the tournament on Monday.

Dean Shimamoto - Head Coach - Varsity Boys Basketball - 'Iolani School - Coach Dean is in his first year as Head Coach of the 'Iolani Varsity Boys Basketball, directed his team in winning the Hawaiian Airlines Boys Basketball State Championship. It was the "Raiders" first state championship since 2006 beating Kamehameha for the title. At the game, over 5,000 people showed up at the Stan Sheriff Center and were standing for the last 18 seconds of the game. With 4.6 seconds left in the game, Kainoa Chu shot the ball to the hoop for a 3 pointer to end the game 46 - 43 in favor of 'Iolani. Coach Dean who was a player for 'Iolani in his high school days, is currently working on his Graduate Degree at the University of Hawaii and is a entrepreneur who owned and operated an Internet Firm for the last ten years. He started coaching in the late 90's with the Intermediate team and joined the Varsity staff in 2001. Coach took over as head coach in April of 2009. During his high school days, he was a starter on the first

ILH and State Champion Basketball Team at 'Iolani. He will cover this year's exciting championship game.
