+ Ron Lee - Football Coach - Saint Louis High School

+ Charles "Kale" Ane III - Associate Athletic Director - Punahou

Ron Lee - Football Coach - Saint Louis High School - Both Lee Brothers (Cal & Ron) have returned to run the Saint Louis High School football program. Coach Ron started his coaching career in 1972 as head coach at Kaiser HS. In 1979 he and his team won the State Oahu Prep Bowl Championship. He left for Willamette University in Salem Oregon in 1981 for a year. In 1982 through 1998 he helped his brother at St. Louis winning 14 prep bowl championships with his run & shoot offense. In 1999 to 2008, under Coach June Jones at the University of Hawai'i, Coach Ron was the Receivers Coach and continued to coach the receivers from 2009 to 2010 under Coach McMakin. In 2010 through 2014, he coached at Kalani HS taking them to their first playoff. We welcome back Coach Ron on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Club luncheon.

Charles (Kale) Ane III - Associate Athletic Director - Head Football Coach - Punahou - The "Buffanblu" ended their 2013 season by winning the Hawai'i High School Athletic Association Division I State Championship, beating Mililani 28-22. Coach Kale will review the 2013 Football Season and talk about his "key" players and returnees for next season. This year, the "Buffanblu" have been ranked nationally 17th in the country for their football program by MaxPreps.com., the American source for High School Sports. Punahou, noted for top athletics programs, have been selected the #1 program on several occasions by Sports Illustrated. Over 70% of the student body, grades 7 through 12, participate in athletic programs at the Punahou school.
