David Trifonovitch - Head Coach - Varsity Boys Soccer - Punahou - Coach David who was the replacement for Bob Clague as Head Coach of the Varsity Boys Soccer Team was the former Coach of the Hawai'i Tsunami professional soccer team, had a very successful 2012-2013 soccer season this year, ending up in second place overall with a record of 9 wins, 2 losses and 2 ties. Punahou lost to Kalani in the state high school tournament 3 to 2. He was raised on Oahu's windward side and has over 25 years of coaching experience at the high school and club levels as well as professional. Coach David played at Cal State Dominguez Hills and has been active in the AYSO and HYSA youth programs. He will give highlights of his team, players and the season on Monday at the HQC luncheon. Coach David will take questions.

Starr Johnson - Head Coach - Varsity Girls Soccer - Punahou - In her first season as Head Coach for the Punahou Girls Soccer Team, Coach Starr and her team ended the season with 13 wins, 3 losses and 1 tie including the state championships. Punahou lost to Iolani 3 -1 in the Outrigger Hotels & Resorts/HHSAA Division I Girls Soccer State Championships. All 3 losses were from playing Iolani. Before becoming head coach, Coach Starr coached the girls JV at the school from 2006. Now as Head Coach, her responsibilities will cover all the girls soccer teams from the immediate to varsity levels she is a Punahou School graduate. Coach Starr will talk about the State finals, her team and her stand-out players on Monday at the luncheon. She will take questions.
