**Eric Kadooka - Head Coach - Punahou School Varsity Baseball Team** - Coach Eric is coaching his 10th year as Head Coach of the Punahou School Varsity Baseball Team with a total of 15 years coaching at the school. Under his coaching, the team has won 6 consecutive HHSAA State Baseball Championships from 2004 to 2009 and the team has played in 22 consecutive tournament games. Coach Eric and his team, the "Bluff N Blu" have won the ILH Championships in 2005, 2007 and 2008. Coach, himself has won State Coach of the Year, in 2004, 2008 and 2009. He will talk about this season and his pitching stars, Jeremy Fujimoto, Marcus Yoshii and freshman sensation Zachary Muenster. Coach Eric is also coaches at The Hawaii Baseball Academy which is a private baseball club. The club is open to all baseball players both boys and girls from 7 to 18 years old of any skill level. Coach Eric will be available for questions at the luncheon.

**Alan Matsui - Head Coach - Girls Basketball Team - Sacred Hearts Academy** - Coach Alan is coaching his 10th year at Sacred Hearts as Head Coach. This season his team went 15 -0 to win the ILH Division II Championship. In 2007, the team won the ILH Division II title 13-0 and was the 2007 State Division II runner-up. Before Sacred Hearts, Coach Alan was Head Coach at Hawaii Baptist Academy for 7 years and in 2001 HBA won the Varsity Small School Championship. Before HBA, he coached at Kamehameha, Leilehua and PAL. Coach Alan will review the season for his team and talk about the "highs and lows" leading up to winning the 2010 ILH Division Title. He will entertain questions from luncheon attendees.
