Joshua Walker – Assistant Coach – Rainbow Warriors – **Men's Volleyball** – University of Hawai'i – Coach Joshua, a former Rainbow Warrior standout and AVCA All-American, has rejoined the University of Hawai'i Men's Volleyball program in 2016 as assistant coach to head coach Charlie Wade. After graduating from UH in 2011, Coach Joshua carried his volleyball career overseas to Greece, Denmark, Finland, and the United Arab Emirates. In 2014-2015 he was an All-Star in the Finland Volleyball League, and also earned MVP honors during his time spent in Denmark in 2014. During his career as a Rainbow Warrior from 2007-11, Coach Joshua served as one of the team's consistent leaders in kills at outside hitter. He finished his four-year career with 1,428 kills (3.91 K/S) and currently ranks fifth in program history. He was named to the All-MPSF second team in 2011 and made the All-MPSF third team as well as second team AVCA All-America in 2010. Coach Joshua received his undergraduate degree in English from the University of Hawai'i in 2011. A 2006 graduate of Tallwood High School in Virginia Beach, he lettered four years in volleyball and two in basketball, before making his way to UH. Coach Walker now resides in Oahu with his wife, Tehane Walker and his daughter Shiloh. Coach Joshua will take questions.
