**Kirk Montgomery – Director of Programming Development – Epic Sports - Terra Firma Media Group, Inc.** – On May 5th, the Inaugural EPIC5 ultra endurance event begins in Hawai'i beginning on the Island of Kaua'i and finishing on the Big Island on May 9th. There will be 5 world-class athletes who will compete in 5 full triathlons (2.4 miles of swimming, 112 miles of cycling and 26.2 miles of running) over 5 consecutive days. The EPIC5 is an ultra-endurance event designed as a physical and spiritual journey for all its athletes. Over 700 miles of swimming, cycling and running in 5 days, EPIC5 is a testament to how proper preparation and a positive attitude can help anyone endure hardships in life. Kirk is skilled in endurance events with an athletic background in College Football, Basketball Bicycle Racing, Surfing, Snowboarding, Skiing, Mixed Martial Arts, Climbing, Mountaineering, Base Jumping, Wing Suits, Adventure Racing, Ice Climbing, AP Pro Volleyball and has expertise in Alaska, Yosemite National Park and here in Hawai'i. Kirk has done stand-in/stunt work for several movie stars, is on-air talent in radio, television and film for over 25 years. He has been involved in the production of the Ironman World Championships, Pro Bowl over 16 PGA and LPGA events including the entire Hawaiian swing of golf session and football. In skiing, Kirk has won a Bronze Medal in the 1991 World Cup Championships and won a Bronze Medal in the 1993 World Cup. In 1992, Kirk won the U.S. National Downhill Championship. Kirk will talk about on how an event of this caliber is planned and executed. He will entertain questions for attendees on Monday at the HQC.

**Adam Yeatts – Assistant Coach – Cheerleading Program – Hawai'i Pacific University** – The large and small co-ed teams from HPU won in the National Cheerleaders Association and National Dance Alliance recently. The HPU Large Co-Ed Cheer Team won its 9th straight national title while the HPU Small Co-Ed Cheer Team won its 5th national title. There are several other competitions the HPU scored high during this event.

The Cheerleading Squad of male and female athletes are highly skilled in gymnastics and partner stunting. The cheerleading squad promotes school spirit for the HPU athletic teams and can be seen performing at the HPU sporting events and community events. HPU has won a total of 14 national titles. Coach Adam has coached the program to the national titles this year. Coach Adam was involved in competitive gymnastics for 14 years and was the Junior Olympic National Champion in 2000. He's is a former HPU Cheerleader and was on the team that won the National Championship in 2007-2008. He is currently working on his Masters Degree in Secondary Education at HPU. Coach Adam will review the cheerleading championships and give us the inside stories the public never hears about on Monday at the HQC.
