+ Hubert Minn - Former Chair - Hawaii State Boxing Commission

Dekita Williams - Assistant Coach - Rainbow Wahine Basketball - University of Hawai'i - Coach Dekita has been a member of the basketball staff since the 2013 -2014 season. She was an assistant coach from 2006-2012 at Mount San Antonio College under Beeman, who was the head coach for the Mounties from 1994-2010. While at Mount San Antonio, Coach Dekita helped guide the basketball team to 3 California state championships in 2007, 2008, and 2012 as well as 6 "Elite Eight" appearances and 6 South coast Conference titles from 2007-2012. She was also a part of a junior college record 45-game win streak. While at Mount San Antonio, she worked with the guards while helping with scouting opponents and recruiting efforts. Coach Dekita was also head coach at the West Coast Premier Basketball Academy's AAU club team from 2007-2012. Coach Dekita started her coaching in 2002-2005 when she was an assistant for the girls' varsity team at Los Osos High School in Rancho Cucamonga, California. She earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in communications in 2002 from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette where she played 2 seasons for the Rajun' Cajuns. While at the University of Louisiana, Coach Dekita appeared in 56 games with 34 starts. As a senior, she averaged 26.3 minutes with 6.8 points, 2.6 assists, and 1.9 rebounds per game. Prior to the University of Louisiana, she received her Associate of Arts degree in liberal studies at Chaffey Community College in Rancho Cucamonga, California where she played 2 seasons for the Panthers. The Rainbow Wahine had their best season in recent history, ending the regular season on a 15-game win streak and capturing their first conference regular season title since 1997-1998. The team ended their season with a 23-9 overall record and a 14-2 in the Big West. She will open for questions at the luncheon.

Hubert BS Minn - Former Chair - Hawai'i State Boxing Commission – Hubert has been involved in boxing for the last 75 years and has served in almost every capacity: boxer, head coach, instructor, manager, match maker, promoter, officiating, association chair, and tournament director. His coaching career began long before he was selected as the first and only University of Hawai'i Boxing Coach. He coached at UH for 10 years and led the university to many national tournaments throughout the mainland. His coaching experience included Armed Forces Boxing Teams and was selected to coach many other Boxing Select Teams in International Competitions. He was also invited to conduct Boxing Clinics and Seminars in Asia and the Pacific. Hubert was instrumental in developing the first National Boxing Champion from the State of Hawai'i. His true love and strength lie in his coaching young fighters the true "Art and Science of Boxing" and demonstrating techniques. Hubert is a Hall of Honor Inductee at McKinley High School and he has been inducted into the Circle of Honor at UH and a nominee for the International

Boxing Hall of Fame. Hubert will give us his insight on the upcoming Mayweather Vs Pacquiao Fight on Saturday May 5th, being touted as the fight of the century and the richest fight in the history of professional boxing.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon.
