Dave Vinton - Director of Sports - Oceanic Time Warner - OC-16 - Dave who has over fifteen years in sports broadcasting returns to the HQC to present the OC-16 latest sports calendar covering live High School sports. He'll cover all the sports events coming up at OC-16 including the schedule for the playoffs. Previously, he was Sports Director at KGMB-9 and was the replacement for Neil Everett who went on to ESPN. Before that, Dave spent seven years as a sports reporter for the station. He is a graduate of Mililani High School and received his BA in Journalism from the University of Hawai'i at Manoa. ScoringLive has grown from a football stats and scores resource for a select number of schools, to a comprehensive news, features, image, video and statistics sports information service providing coverage of nearly every high school sport taking place in the state of Hawai'i, including the OIA, ILH, BIIF, MIL and KIF. Wes has a by-line of prep news that has made his name synonymous with Hawaii high school athletics and his blog, Prep Talk, is one of the most popular mediums for discussing and debating high school sports topics in the state. Wes will entertain questions.
