David's work has appeared in such publications as *Sports Illustrated*, the *New York Times*, and *SB Nation*. He is a contributing writer with the *Los Angeles Magazine* and a contributing editor with "Sportsletter." David started his career at the *L.A. Weekly*, where his story about boxer Jerry Quarry was anthologized in the "Best American Sports Writing" series. David will have a supply of his books with him and he will sign copies for luncheon attendees who purchase his book. David carried us on a historical journey of Duke Kahanamoku's life the first time he appeared at the Honolulu Quarterback Club in February. His story was so intriguing, we asked him back to share more historical facts.
