Robert Helsham, Sr. – Director of Athletics – Christian Academy – Robert has been Christian Academy's Director of Athletics since the ILH approved the schools request to participate in 2002. Since then Christian Academy has continued to grow and competes in the ILH with our stand alone basketball, cross country, track, and volleyball teams and participates in the PAC5 and WestPAC programs for football, soccer, and baseball. Christian Academy is located at the top of Red Hill and is a ministry of the First Assembly of God Church. The school was founded in 1981 when the church was then located in Lunalilo. The high school began in 1999 and first graduating class of 2 was in May 2002.

Raion Black – Junior - Track & Field Athlete – Christian Academy – Raion has been attending Christian Academy since Kindergarten. Now a junior in high school she has been a Patriot for over 10 years. She has always had her sites set high in reaching goals set before her. As an 8 grader in 2009 she tied the ILH intermediate record in the 100m and set a new record in the 200m. As a freshman she was an ILH 2nd team all star and an HHSAA State Track and Field participant. Last year as a sophomore she captured the ILH title in the 100, 200, 400. She was HHSAA state champion in the 100m and runner up in the 200m. ILH 1st team all star. This year she once again captured the ILH titles in the 100, 200, 400. She has earned a spot at the upcoming HHSAA State Track and Field tournament in Hilo next weekend. She continues to strive for excellence both on and off the field by being very active in her church and community. Her current GPA of 3.98 reflects a well rounded and grounded scholar-athlete that we are proud to call a Christian Academy Patriot.
