**+ George Lumpkin – Director Player Personnel – UH Football Warriors**  
**+ Carmyn James – Head Coach – UH Women's Track & Field Coach**

**George Lumpkin – Director of Player Personnel – Football Warriors - University of Hawai'i** - Coach George begins his 34th year on the coaching staff and ranks as one of the senior members in UH Sport's Programs. In total, he has been affiliated with UH sports for a total of 37 years, including 2 years as a player and 2 as a graduate assistant. Spring football practice is over and most of the positions are set. This up-coming season, Coach George will spend all his time as Director of Player Personnel. There are 46 returning players, 24 on offense, 20 on defense and 2 kickers. Also, there are 9 new recruits and other newcomers. Who are they and how will these players help the team? What did the coaches learn from the practice/scrimmage that was held on the Big Island? What are positions are still in question? Coach George will give us the inside stories at the Honolulu Quarterback Club Luncheon on Monday.

**Camyn James - Head Coach - Women's Track & Field Program - University of Hawai'i** - Coach Camyn took over the the women's track & field program in 2001 at UH. Coach, over the past 7 years has overseen a multi-million dollar resurfacing project for Cook Field, the establishment of an indoor track and field program and an outdoor squad which barely fielded a team at the Western Athletic Conference Championships in her first year to a 5th place finish at last year's competition. This year so far, Coach Camyn has coached Samatha Balentine to being named Verizon WAC player of the week in April. Also, triple jumper Madara Apine was also named Verizon WAC player of the week, the week previously. In the final tune-up before the WAC Championships to be held at UH-Moana, May 9th through May 13th, the team set 3 personal bests and 5 team bests at the Steve Scott Invitational. Coach Carmyn will review the Steve Scott Invitational and talk about hosting the WAC Conference Championships. She'll give a run-down of all the events.
