Kaiser High School's 4x400 meter relay team - At OIA Track & Field finals, Kaiser High School's team broke the OIA meet record with a time of 4:00.43. The team also broke the Punahou Relays record a week before. Team members Tommi Hintnaus, Celine Lum, Kristen O'Handley and Teuila Gardner will be competing for the state championship on Maui this week. The Cougars of Kaiser won the meet for the 2nd year in a row taking home not only the title for the meet but 6 individual medals. Teuila Gardner won the high jump and the 800 meter run and finished 2nd behind teammate Kristen O'Handley in 400 meter. Celine Lum won the pole vault clearing 12 feet, 1 inch and ended 2nd in the 800 meter run. Teammate Tommi Hintnaus who placed 2nd in the pole vault comes from a family whose father pole vaulted in the Olympics and won the 1980 US Olympic Trials and her sister was a state champion in the pole vault while attending Kaiser High School. Coach Kevin is a World and US ranked track and field athlete himself. The coach and team members will be available for questions from luncheon attendees.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon.
