Today's luncheon is devoted to Mother's Day and we have a Daughter & Mother combination for our Speakers. It's no wonder, Charlinda is a champion track & field athlete, the genes have been passed on from her Mom. The Honolulu Quarterback Club has been following Charlinda from her high school days and now she will give us an update on UH 2017 Track & Field Events and talk about her Mom.

Charlinda Ioane - Senior - Track & Field (Throws) - University of Hawai'i - Charlinda has been a track & field star since high school at Kapolei and during 2016 while attending UH has continued to excel in both discus and shot put qualifying for the NCAA Division I West Preliminary Round in both events finishing 28th in the discus throw preliminaries, and finished 48th in the shotput preliminaries. Here are some additional outdoor season highlights from 2016: She won bronze in the discus throw at the Big West Outdoor Championships and finished 7th in the shotput event, set a personal record of 49-9.75 in the shot put at the Beach Pacific Coast Event and won a silver medal. She now holds the team's 2nd best mark for this season in the disc throw from the Big West Championships and is ranked 4th on the University's outdoor all-time top 10 list for the shot put and 5th for the discus throw.

Davilyn Neilson - Past High School Champion - Softball - Basketball - (Mother of Charlinda) - While attending High School, Davilyn was an accomplished athlete in softball, basketball, bowling, and track and field. She lettered for 4 years and graduated 23rd in her high school class with a grade point average of 3.8. Davilyn ended high school being part of the team winning both the 1984 OIA East Varsity Softball Championship and the 1984 OIA Varsity Softball Championship. Between 1981 to 1984 she enjoyed playing on several winning basketball and softball teams while attending high school. She went on the BYUH with an academic scholarship and studied Early Education.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon.
