Hebert BS Minn – Chair – Hawai'i State Boxing Commission – Herbert has been involved in Boxing for the last 75 years and has served in almost every capacity, boxer, head coach, instructor, manager, match maker, promoter, officiating, association chair, tournament director and currently Chairman of the Hawai'i State Boxing Commission. His coaching career began long before he was selected as the first and only University of Hawai'i Boxing Coach. He coached at UH for 10 years and led the university to many national tournaments throughout the mainland. His coaching experience included Armed Forces Boxing Teams and was selected to coach many other Boxing Select Teams in International Competitions. He was also invited to conduct Boxing Clinics and Seminars in Asia and the Pacific. Herbert was instrumental in developing the first National Boxing Champion from the State of Hawai'i. His true love and strength lie in his coaching young fighters the true "Art and Science of Boxing" and demonstrating techniques. Herbert is a Hall of Honor Inductee at McKinley High School and he has been inducted into the Circle of Honor at UH and a nominee for the International Boxing Hall of Fame.

Gordon Yuen – Golf Coach – Moanalua High School – Moanalua won both the team and individual state titles in boy's golf at the David S. Ishii Foundation 2012 HHSAA Golf Championships held the first week in May. Coach Gordon guided his team to overcome a four-stroke lead that 'Iolani had after the first day to finish four-strokes ahead in the final round. Coach Gordon will be bringing two members of the Championship Team, seniors, **Seung Jae Maeng and Jefferson Yee**. He will introduce his seniors at the luncheon.
