Bob Hogue - Commissioner - Pacific West Conference - Commissioner Bob has been his job since 2007 year and and returns to the HQC to update us on the the spring activities for the Pacific West Conference. The current roster of Schools in the PacWest are, Academy of Art University, Brigham Young University-Hawai'i, Chaminade University, Dixie State College of Utah, Dominican University of California, Grand Canyon University, University of Hawai'i at Hilo, Hawaii Pacific University and Notre Dame de Namur University. Bob has been involved in television broadcasting for more than 30 years, spent time in print media and was a State Senator for the State of Hawai'i. Currently Bob hosts a sports talk show. PacWest Magazine on Radio and is the host of PacWest Magazine on OC-16 Television. In addition, Bob is a Sports Columnist for Midweek. Bob will bring us up-to-date on the spring season for all the sports in the PacWest, including the Commissioner's Cup. Commissioner Bob will take questions from attendees at the Honolulu Quarterback Club Luncheon on Monday.

Rich Miano - Associate Head Coach - Secondary - University of Hawai'i "Football Warriors" – Coach Rich enters his 13th year at the University of Hawai'i and his 4th season as Associate Head Coach for the team. Coach Rich, who was a former safety at UH, was a walk-on at the University and has created his secondary from overachieving walk-ons and continues to monitor that program. There are 25 high school and junior college prospects for the 2011 upcoming season which was about 80% of all the players that the "Warriors" Football Staff had targeted. Coach Rich will highlight some of the recruit's backgrounds, like defensive back Mike Edwards who played his freshman year at Tennessee, Chris Grant a junior college All-American, Chinedu Promise Amadi who earned postseason high school honors, linebacker Brenden Daley who was rated the

44th best prospect in junior college and Will Gregory who was rated the 46th best running back prospect in the U.S. Coach Rich will give us all the inside stories on Monday at the HQC.
