Dave Reardon - Feature Sports Columnist - "After Further Review" - Honolulu Star-Bulletin -
Dave returns to the Quarterback Luncheon on Monday and will talk about the "State of the sports in Hawai'i". He'll discuss the possible WAC changes when and if Boise State and Fresno State leave the WAC. What are the revenue ramifications for the University of Hawaii? Dave is a graduate of Pearl City High School, and attended Northwestern and the University of Hawaii. Charlie Wade - Head Coach - Men's Volleyball - University of Hawaii - Coach
Charlie completed his freshman season as Head Coach with excellent results. The Warriors ended their season 19-10 and made it to the Mountain West Playoffs only losing to Stanford (the mainland Hawai'i player's team). Leading the Warriors, in Coach Charlie's first year as head coach, was Jonas Umlauf who was named American Volleyball Coaches Association's (AVCA) Newcomer of the Year and first-team All American and Joshua Walker who was named All American, second team. Umlauf was also awarded the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Freshman of the Year. In addition to the individual player recognition, the AVCA awarded the University of Hawai'i Men's Volleyball Team the inaugural Volleyball Market/AVCA Men's Play of the Year, as a part of the newly created Volleyball Market/AVCA Play of the Week program. Almost 2,000 votes were cast to determine the winner, with the Warriors beating out two other universities during the designated week-long voting period. The play was during the Warrior's home match against UC Irvine in January. The play shows Joshua Walker setting up for an attack and, ultimately, killing the ball off the head of one of the UC Irvine players. The kill enabled the Warriors to break a 27-27 tie in the second game, and Hawai'i went on to win the set and win the match. Coach will take questions.

George Gusman - Director of Baseball - Head Varsity Baseball Coach - Saint Louis - The Saint Louis Baseball Team reached the semi-finals for this year's state tournament. The "Crusaders" played Mid-Pacific in the State Championships but lost 8-5 and finished in 4th Place. This was Coach George's first year as Head Coach. Previously he was the Saint Louis Head Coach of JV Baseball for the past 11 years and before that he was the Varsity assistant Baseball Coach at Kamehameha. In addition to baseball, Coach George is a Big 12 Football Official and previously he served as a WAC Football Official and was a Football Official for the OIA. Coach George will review the baseball season for the "Crusaders" and talk about his players and highlight some of most exciting games the team played. Coach will be available for questions on Monday at the Quarterback Luncheon.
