Marilyn Moniz-Kaho'ohanohano - Associate Athletics Director – Senior Woman Administrator - University of Hawai'i - Marilyn returns to the HQC entering her 24th year at the University. Her responsibilities include overseeing women's volleyball, soccer, water polo, cheerleading, men's golf, men and women's tennis, sailing, men and women's swimming and diving, plus the newly created sand volleyball program. At the same time, Marilyn monitors gender equity and NCAA compliance within the department. One of her major priorities is make sure the athletic department is in compliance with the Patsy T. Mink Act (Title IX). Marilyn continues to also supervise student services/academics. She also contributes to reaching the department's goal of financial stability while making improvements in the areas of student services and creating additional academic services for the student-athletes and enhancing their life skills and compliance. Marilyn is to be honored at the YWCA's 37th Annual Leader Luncheon on Tuesday, June 3rd.

Dakota Grossman - Track & Field - Seabury Hall - Dakota will be making an appearance at the Honolulu Quarterback Club luncheon. She was selected as one of twelve high school athletes for this year's 2014 Hawai'i Hall of Honor. Dakota has had a fabulous high school athletic career as a runner for Seabury Hall. Recently, she won the gold in the 1,500 and 3,000 meter runs at the state track and field championships and finished third in the 800. Dakota has won the gold in the 3,000 long distant run four times in four years and she won two gold medals in the 1,500. In addition, she also has won the girls' cross country state title all four years. She will be receiving the Female Sports Person of the Month Award for 2 different months at the luncheon on Monday.
