Marilyn Moniz-Kaho'ohanohano - Associate Athletics Director - Senior Woman Administrator - University of Hawai'i - Marilyn returns to the HQC entering her 23rd. year at the University. Her responsibilities include overseeing women's volleyball, soccer, water polo, cheerleading, men's golf, men and women's tennis, sailing, men and women's swimming and diving plus the newly created sand volleyball program. At the same time, Marilyn monitors gender equity and NCAA compliance within the department. One of her major priorities is make sure the athletic department is in compliance with the Patsy T. Mink Act (Title IX). Marilyn continues to also supervise student services/academics. She also contributes to reaching the department's goal of financial stability while making improvements in the areas of student services and creating additional academic services for the student-athletes and enhancing their life skills and compliance. Marilyn will be available for questions from luncheon attendees on Monday at the HQC luncheon.

Doris Sullivan – Founder/President – Pacific Islands Athletic Alliance – Doris started her company in 2003 and since PIAA has assisted 1,250 Hawai'i and 100 American Samoa students secure over \$18M in athletic and academic grants and scholarships. Previously, Doris was Director of Students for the Hawai'i Sports Network and was a Bank manager for Bank of America and worked for the NBA Washington Wizards. Doris is the daughter of Italian Immigrants and was the first female in her family to graduate from College. During her collegiate years, she played tennis for the University of Maryland. She is married to Bill, a retired NCIS agent and has two sons; Billy who graduated from Damien and is a graduate of the US Air Force Academy where he played football and lacrosse. and is currently a fighter pilot; Kevin who graduated from St. Louis where he was a star running back is currently attending the University of Arizona and is working on his Master's degree. The PIAA recently completed a High School Football Combine on the new turf at Castle High School. Doris will give us highlights on the event.
