The Honolulu Quarterback Club, celebrating 66 Years, is pleased to announce the following Guest Speaker for their luncheon, Monday, June 18th., at the MGR:

+ Sailala (Sue) Zumbado – Throws Coach - Women's Track & Field -University of Hawai'i

Sailala (Sue) Zumbado - Throws Coach - Women's Track & Field –University of Hawai'i – Coach Sei is in her first season as an assistant coach in-charge of the throwers in the UH track and field program. She is a 7 time NCAA Champion (4 time in Discus and 3 time in Shot Put). No other NCAA female athlete has ever won that many titles and she is just the 2nd one in history to win 4 consecutive titles - all in discus. She is also a 2 time Olympian for the USA (2000 & 2004) and she has been a finalist at 2 World Championships. Before her current assignment, Coach Sei was the throwing coach at Cal State Northridge for the last 5 years. During her career, she trained 25 student-athletes, who qualified for the NCAA West Regionals. Coach Sei will give us a report on the the results of the 2012 NCAA Outdoor and Field Championships recently held on the mainland. She will talk about the activities of UH senior, TeRina Keenan, who has had a lot of local publicity, finished ninth in the discus in the tournament. TeRina completed her career being one of UH's top throwers of all time. She won 5 career medals (three gold and two silver) and was involved in 4 NCAA Regional events. Coach Se will take questions from luncheon attendees on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback luncheon.
