Charlie Wade - Head Coach – Men's Volleyball - University of Hawai'i - Coach Charlie finished his 4th season as Head Coach of the Men's Volleyball Team. Although the team didn't qualify for the postseason, the team finished 15-12 overall and 13-11 in the MPSF. There were 5 wins over 4 good teams that were ranked nationally including No. 3 UCLA, No. 2 BYU, and semifinalist Penn State. The team finished 9-3 at home and ended up in 9th place for the season. There were 5 players who ended up being selected to the MPSF All-Academic Team, Taylor Averill and Johann Timmer earned their 3rd. MPSF All-Academic Award while Sinisa Zarkovic, setter Joby Ramos, and libero Kolby Kanetake were 1st yr. awardees. Coach Charlie will review the season and talk about is recruits especially Kekoa "Koa" Pukahi who was selected as one of ten players nationally as a High School Senior first team All-American.

Ed Kemper - Road Race Car Driver - Attorney - Ed was an active road race car driver at Hawai'i Raceway Park, was an instructor training new race car drivers, and is the assistant regional executive for the Hawaii Region of the Sports Car Club of America.
