Marilyn Moniz-Kaho'ohanohano - Associate Athletics Director - Senior Woman Administrator - University of Hawai'i - Marilyn returns to the HQC entering her 21st. year at the University. Her responsibilities include overseeing women's volleyball, soccer, water polo, cheerleading, men's golf, men and women's tennis, sailing and men and women's swimming and diving. At the same time, Marilyn monitors gender equity and NCAA compliance within the department. One of her major priorities is make sure the athletic department is in compliance with the Patsy T. Mink Act (Title IX). She continues to also supervise student services/academics. She also contributes to reaching the department's goal to reach financial stability while making improvements in the areas of student services and creating additional academic services for the student-athletes and enhancing their life skills, and compliance. Charlinda Ioane – Senior – Track & Field – Kapolei High School – Charlinda participated in the 2012 Girls State Track and Field Championships and not only took 1st. place in the shot put, but broke the record with a distance of 45-9.75. She also ended up in 2nd place in the discus with a distance of 128.04. She is headed for UH in the fall and will be a member of the track & field team there. Charlinda plays other sports too. She has been either Captain or Co-Captain of the volleyball team and same for basketball. In her spare time she volunteers with Special Olympics Hawai'i, the Hawai'i Down Syndrome Congress, the Girl Scouts and is heavily involved in her church activities. She has won many top awards during her high school days in both field & track, and volleyball. Charlinda was just selected as the 2011-2012 Gatorade Hawai'i Girls State Track and Field Athlete of the Year. This was the first time this award was given to an athlete from Kapolei High School.
