- **Amber Kaufman - 2009 Adult Female of the Year**
- **Carmyn James - Head Coach - Women's Track & Field - UH**
- **"The Sports Animals" - Chris Hart & Gary Dickman**

Amber Kaufman - Recipient of the 2009 Adult Female of the Year - Amber was selected by members of the Quarterback Club for her athletic achievements in smashing the UH high jump record and the nation's best jump (6 ft -1.25 inch) at this year's WAC Outdoor Championships. But, in 2009, she was named co-field Athlete of the Meet; placed 3rd at the NCAA Outdoor Championships (in the high jump), first UH athlete to medal at the event in 25 years; named All-American for both indoor and outdoor seasons; first UH athlete to win an NCAA Regional event in the high jump; won the WAC indoor championship; placed 6th at the NCAA Indoor Championships and named to the national and WAC all-academic team. Also, Amber was named 1st team all-WAC in volleyball, received a honorable mention All-American; and led the WAC in hitting, and was 2nd in service aces and blocks. This year, Amber has been selected to represent Team USA at this summer's track and field North American, Central American, Caribbean (NACAC) Championships.

Carmyn James - Head Coach - Women's Track & Field - University of Hawaii - Coach Carmyn in her 9th year as Head Coach for the "Rainbow Wahine", has fielded a team that has become a force in the WAC and the West Region. She and Amber just returned recently from the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Championships. Coach Carmyn will give us a complete run-down on the results of the tournament at Monday's luncheon.
