Allan Silva - Head Coach - Varsity Basketball - Saint Louis School - Coach Allan recently finished his first year as the new Varsity Basketball Coach for Saint Louis High School. For the previous 11 years, he was Head Coach for the boy's varsity basketball program at Farrington High School. His teams at Farrington won two Division II state championships, one OIA Division II title and two OIA Division I championships. At Saint Louis, two of Coach Allan's basketball players, Tristan Nichols (Center) & Jaymason Nunuha (Guard), were ranked in the HHSAA top 10. In recognition of his efforts, Coach Allan received a commendation from the Hawaii State Senate as an Outstanding Advocate for Children and Youth in the State of Hawai'i. He graduated from Kailua High School and Chaminade University, where he was a basketball standout. While at Chaminade, his basketball skills were developed under the direction of his coach and mentor, Merv Lopes. Coach Allan is Sports Certified in the Fundamentals of Coaching, Concussion and Heat Illness by the National Federation of State High School Associations. In addition to coaching, Coach Allan spends time as a Teacher/Counselor at the Aloha Learning Center where he provides education and guidance for at risk youth from the Kalihi area. At Monday's luncheon, Coach Allan will review his team's performance during his first year at Saint Louis.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available.
