+ **John Campbell – Campbell Pacific - Royal Hawai'i Rugby Union**
+ **Dan Epstein -Vice President – Special Olympics Hawai'i**

John Campbell - Campbell Pacific/Royal Hawaii Rugby Union - John, a former president and life-time member of the HQC is back from his home in San Diego. He will talk about the Club and the characters from the 70's to the 90's and the Sports person of the Month and Year. He will also talk about an upcoming Rugby Championship that will be played on Oahu in November this year at the Kapiolani Park. He will entertain questions on Monday at the HQC Luncheon.

Dan Epstein – Vice President – Sports & Sports Marketing – Special Olympics Hawai'i – Dan has been involved with Special Olympics for 18 years and currently works for the organization as VP of Sports. For the 2011 World Summer Games, he served as the Sport Manager for Aquatics in charge of 40 swimmers and 13 coaches. He has attended numerous World Games and in the past he was the Head of the Delegation for Hawai'i at the 1995 and 1999 World Games. Dan was Assistant Coach of aquatics at the 2003 and 2007 World Games and was the Head of the Delegation for Hawai'i at the 2006 National Games. In addition, Dan coordinates competition and coaches training for all Special Olympics Hawai'i sports and also coaches youth lacrosse and soccer. Dan will talk about this year's World Summer Games and introduce **Nicolas Pang** who competed in powerlifting at this year's games held in Greece, where he won 2 Gold Medals (Deadlift & Combined) and 2 Fourth Place Ribbons (Squat & Bench Press). Nicolas has participated in Special Olympics for 17 years, competing in basketball, softball and bowling. Both Dan and Nicolas will talk questions at the Honolulu Quarterback Luncheon on Monday at the Maple Garden.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King

and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available.
