Nadia Hata – Former member of the Maryknoll Rifle Team – Nadia Hata is a 2014 alumni of Maryknoll High School. Nadia was Maryknoll's scholar-athlete. She has been participating in the sport of Riflery since the eighth grade. Nadia has participated in the Hawaii State Sporter Championships three times and she is the 2013 Girl's State Champion. She has also competed in the Junior National Championships twice and she is the co-holder of the NRA National Record for the Prone Position. Nadia will be attending the University of Mississippi in the fall. She will be shooting on the Rebel's Rifle team. Nadia will talk about how she planned to earn a college scholarship at Ole Miss this fall as a shooter for the University.

Yuji Hata – **Rifle Coach** – **Pack 5** – Yuji is the Riflery coach for Pack 5 along with his wife Robyn. He has been coaching for almost 4 years. In addition to coaching he also makes slings for air rifles and small-bore rifles. He will entertain questions.

Gavin MT Au – Former member Leilehua Air Rifle Team – Gavin, who is a collegiate Athlete at the University of Nevada, was on the Leilehua Air Rifle Team for 4 years. While in high school and being on the rifle team there, he developed tools to become a successful college athlete. He currently is majoring in electrical engineering. Gavin, while at Leilehua, was a member of the 1st All-Star Team, an OIA Boys Individual Champion, a HHSAA Boys Individual State Champion, a Leilehua High School Air Rifle MVP, a Hawaii State Qualifier (Sporter), a NRA Junior Air Rifle Sporter Standing Sectional Champion and won a 1st Place NRA National Indoor Junior Championship. Gavin will explain the difference between collegiate and high school shooting on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Club luncheon meeting.

James Esteban – Coach – Leilehua Boys and Girls Air Rifle Team – Coach James has been coaching at Leilehua since 2005. He originally graduated from Leilehua High School in 1998 and was a member of the rifle team from his freshman year through his senior year. While at Leilehua, he shot small bore (22 caliber) and shot air rifles. He was on a team that was National Champions in the air

rifle 3-postion sporter. Coach James became Leilehua's Boys and Girls Air Rifle coach after his high school coach retired. Coach James will be available to entertain questions.

Paul Davis – Assistant Rifle Coach – USMC Wounded Warrior Regiment – Coach Paul is a member of the NRA/CMP/USAS National Coach Development Staff; Level III Coach/Instructor; a Head Coach and a coach at the multiple Junior Olympic Shooting Camps located at the US Olympic Training Center. He has been a Head Coach of multiple NRA National Junior Advanced Shooting Camps, plus regional and area shooting camps plus a Head Coach of the Union High School Stingers Rifle Team, whose teams won 11 National Championships and had 11 National Champions, and 11 team members who obtained NCAA grants-in-aid. He coached two former team members into becoming NCAA All Americans. He has received numerous national awards from the NRA for outstanding club programs. He is a former Operations Officer at the US Army Marksmanship Training Unit. Coach Paul has been an Assistant Coach for the US Shooting Team, participated in the 2005 World Cup and was inducted into the Union Country High School Athletic Hall of Fame 2012. Coach James is an Assistant Coach for the All Marine Team in 2012, 2013, 2014 at the DOD Wounded Warrior Games and has been an Assistant Rifle Coach for the USMC Wounded Warrior Regiment starting in 2012. Coach Paul will talk about the Wounded Warrior Program and will reveal some inside stories he has personally experienced.
