Merv Lopes – Former Head Coach - Chaminade University Basketball - & Namesake for the Pete Newell Big Man Camp - Coach Merv, now retired, not really is still involved in his free youth clinic with the Pete Newell Big Man Camp at the Manoa Recreation Center. The camp runs during the last few days the end of this month. The basketball players, both boys and girls are divided into 3 groups, 14-16 year olds, 16-18 year olds and college players. Rich Miano - Head Coach – Football - Kaiser High School & Founder of Hawai'i Speed & Quickness – Coach Rich, the former University of Hawai'i Associate Head Coach, has recently accepted the position of Kaiser High School's Head Football Coach. He is a 1980 Kaiser High School graduate and was a walk-on safety at UH where he honed his skills and became an outstanding player. After college, he played for three professional football teams during his 11-years in the National Football League. Coach returned to UH as an assistant coach for 13 years and was associate head coach his last 4 years. He also co-founded Hawai'i Speed and Quickness in 2000 and he is involved at all levels of services from design, research and implementation. He also is a volunteer at local schools, churches and the Cancer Association. The staff at speed and quickness are scholar athletes that are trained in mentoring. Former stand-outs Leonard Peters Krisha Kai, Chad Owens, Colt Brennan, Devone Bess, Kelly Ong, Ryan, Grice-Mullins, Koren Takeyama Matt Inouye have contributed to the success of the organization. Coach Rich will entertain questions.
