Michele "Bud" Nagamine – Head Coach – Wahine Soccer – University of Hawai'i. The 2012 Wahine soccer schedule is out and highlights 11 home games with 3 of those games against 2011 NCAA Tournament teams. The season opens with 2 games on the road against Nevada and UNLV. The first game of the season at home is scheduled against Sacred Heart on Friday, August 24th in the Ohana Hotels & Resorts No Ka Oi Tournament. Coach Michele is entering her 2nd season as Head Coach for the Wahine Soccer. For the 2012 Season, Coach Michele has received commitments from 10 new players. UH had a 5-12-1 overall record last season and finished tied for 3rd place with a record of 4-2-1 in the WAC. The Wahine have been picked to finish tied for last place along with UC Riverside in the Big West. No Wahine were selected for the 12-person pre season All-Big West Team. She will give us a run-down on all her recruits, players and the the 2012 schedule on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Luncheon.

Karen Finley - Head Coach - Punahou - Coach Karen has been with the Punahou Team for 20 years. She, along with her brother, started shooting by taking a Hunter's Safety Course to make sure they were handling their rifles safely. Her first competitions started as a member of a shooting club on the mainland. After that, she spent 4 years competing as a member of the UCLA Women's Rifle Team and served as team captain during her senior year. 18 years later, Coach Karen moved to Hawai'i and started as a volunteer assistant coach of the Punahou Rifle Team and 2 years later became head coach. The Punahou Rifle Team recently participated and were successful at the Junior Olympic Rifle Competitions. Coach Karen will tell us all about it on Monday.
