Dave Reardon - Feature Sports Columnist - Honolulu Star-Advertiser - Dave returns to the Honolulu Quarterback Club and will talk about the upcoming season for the UH Warriors Football program. He'll give us the inside stories directly from the football playing field. Which football players does he think will be the "stars" this season? He'll give us his opinion about the UH Quarterbacks and new coaches. Dave has been a professional sports writer for over 30 years. He is a feature sports columnist for the Honolulu Star-Advertiser and is a Honolulu native and an alumnus of Pearl City High, Northwestern University and the University of Hawaii. Dave started as a copyboy and prep football stringer at the Star-Bulletin in 1981 and has covered the island sports scene uninterrupted since, except for college and two years at the Gainesville (Fla.) Sun. He has won numerous state and national awards for feature writing, columns and breaking news. Dave writes the "further review" column. Dave will take questions from attendees on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Club luncheon.

Laurie Baker & Kathy Carey - Members of the Leahi 050 Soccer Team - In July, the Leahi 050 team won the National Championship trophy from the USASA Veteran's Cup held in Virginia Beach. The Veteran's Cup is run by the United States Adult Soccer Association and moves from region to region every few years --- the team has competed in the last 7 years' tournaments in Lancaster, MA, Sanford, FL, San Diego, CA and Virginia Beach, VA. Leahi 050 has been in the semis or finals in all seven years that it competed in the Cup and brought the trophy home 4 of the 7 years---2009, 2010, 2012 and 2015---beating teams from Maryland and San Diego. The competition comes from many different states --- Connecticut, Texas, Washington, California, Michigan, Ohio, Massachusetts, Georgia, Virginia/Metro DC --- and it is always a fun and competitive tournament. After two years in Virginia Beach, the Cup is slated to move back to Southern California next year. Leahi 050 is ready to defend the championship next year. Laurie & Kathy will talk about the team's challenges and highlights from the tournament.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon.
