Mike Brown - Head Diving Coach & Anita Rossing Asst. Diving Coach - University of Hawai'i - The season will mark Coach Mike's 30th year in coaching college diving and he and his wife, Anita Rossing are entering their 12th season coaching at UH. Divers at UH have won 2 individual NCAA diving titles in 2005 and 2008 and in the 2005-06 season, the women's team was the top point scoring diving team in the 2006 NCAA Championships. While at UH, Coach Mike has been named WAC Diving Coach of the Year 7 times. Both coaches continue to recruit talented divers who are high academic achievers as well. Coach Mike will be inducted into the University of Texas Women's Athletics Hall of Honor where he coach the Texas Longhorns from 1976 to 1994. During that time, he was selected as National Diving Coach of the year 3 times and his teams participated in 14 national championships and 31 conference title tournaments. He served as the 1992 Olympic coach and worked as a U.S. national team coach for 17 years. Coaches Mike and Anita will talk about the Olympics Swimming and Diving competition and compare the Olympians of past years to today's competitors.

Dave Reardon - Feature Sports Writer - Honolulu Star-Advertiser - Dave returns to the HQC and will talk UH Warriors Football and the Olympics. He'll give us the inside stories directly from the football playing field. Which Warrior football players does his think will be the "stars" this season?
