**Dave Reardon - Feature Sports Columnist - "After Further Review"/ "Quick Read" blog - Honolulu Star-Advertiser** - Dave returns to the Quarterback Luncheon on Monday and will give us a report on the University of Hawaii Football "Warriors" fall camp. He'll discuss all the team positions and who he thinks will make the team, including inside stories on the new recruits, Quarterback Moniz, the backfield, and the offense and defense. Dave is a graduate of Pearl City High School, and attended Northwestern and the University of Hawaii. Dave has been a professional sports writer for over 30 years, working for the new Honolulu Star-Bulletin, Gainesville Florida Sun, Honolulu Advertiser and now the new Honolulu Star-Advertiser. Dave picked the "Warriors" to finish fifth in the WAC this season.

**Dave Vinton - Director of Sports - Oceanic Time Warner - OC-16** - Dave who has over fourteen years in sports broadcasting returns to the HQC to present the OC-16 fall sports calendar. He'll cover all the sports events coming up at OC-16. Previously, he was Sports Director at KGMB-9 and was the replacement for Neil Everett who went on to ESPN. Before that, Dave spent seven years as a sports reporter for the station. He is a graduate of Mililani High School and received his BA in Journalism from the University of Hawai'i at Manoa. Dave has recently married and Howard Dashefsky was his emcee for the wedding reception. Was the wedding a sports event? Dave will give an example of the "play by play" during the wedding.

**Howard Dashefsky - OC-16 Sportscaster - Host and Producer of "Sports People Hawaii" Oceanic Time Warner** - Howard has been in broadcasting for over twenty-three years here in Hawai'i. He currently hosts and produces "Sports People Hawaii" and provides "play by play" sportscasts for OC-16. Howard writes for several publications and has his own consulting company, "Dash Communications" which specializes in Community and Media relations as well as public relations and video production. He also teaches Journalism at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa. Howard will show us his program on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Luncheon.

**Linda Kaiser - Channel/Ocean Swimmer - Hawaii Swimming Hall of Fame** Not only has Linda swam the channels 7 times, she has completed over 50 marathons and ultra runs. The shortest channel crossing was 7 miles which had a time of 3.5 hours and the longest swim was 27 miles with a time 15 hours. Linda has also completed in all 29 Hawaii Tinman Triathlons. Linda was inducted into the Hawaii Swimming Hall of Fame two years ago and was honored as the 2008 Senior Athlete of the Year by the Honolulu Quarterback Club. She will be presenting information on a major swimming event here.
