Tommy Kono – Vice President Honolulu Marathon Association – Olympic & World Weightlifting Champion – Tommy, Olympic Gold Medalist and World Weightlifting Champion, former Coach in Olympic Weightlifting for countries, Mexico, West Germany and the United States, Author, Physical Fitness Specialist for the Department of Parks & Recreation City & County of Honolulu and Life Time Member of the Honolulu Quarterback Club was active in the development and staging of the Honolulu Marathon from the very beginning in 1973. The very first Honolulu Marathon 38 years ago had only 167 runners compared to Sunday's 21,000 plus entrants. Tommy will describe Sunday's marathon, and talk about the revenue that the marathon generates for Hawai'i every year. This event does not receive any funding support from the Hawai'i Tourism Authority. Tommy will be available to answer any question from Quarterback Club luncheon attendees.

Steven Tsai – UH Football Warriors Beat Reporter – Star-Advertiser - Steven returns to the Honolulu Quarterback Club after reporting on a very successful football season for the University of Hawai'i. He'll talk about all the records that have fallen from playing performances of this year's UH "Warriors Team". In the San Jose game, Quarterback Bryant Moniz set a new record of 560 yards beating Colt Brennan's 2006 record of 559 yards. In the New Mexico game, Running Back Alex Green rushed for 327 yards and broke a 60 year old record rushing at UH. He'll talk about the success of the receiving stars, scholar, Kealoha Pilaes and the fabulous UH record setting Greg Salas who beat Jason Rivers receiving record. Steven will report on the the offense which was noted at the beginning of the season to be the weakness of this years team and the defense which proved in almost every game the ability to stop running plays. Also, Steven will describe the playing of Linebacker Corey Paredes and Safeties, Mana Silva and Richard Torres and the performance of Place-Kicker Scott Enos who broke Jason Elam's PAT record. Steven will talk story and entertain questions.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking
