Bob Hogue - Commissioner - Pacific West Conference - Commissioner Bob has been his job since 2007 year and returns to the HQC to update us on the Maui Invitational completed at the end of November. In the fall, the Pacific West selects champions in men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, and men's and women's cross country, while in the winter season the PacWest focuses on men's and women's basketball.
