**Wendell Look - Head Football Coach - Iolani School** – The last time we heard Coach Wendell was in 2007. This year he returns to the HQC to talk about the Iolani "Raiders" winning the ILH Division II Title and the State Division II Championship. This is the 4th Year in a row that the "Raiders" have won the State Title. In the Championship Game, Iolani set a record in scoring for the most points since Punahou beat Leilehua in 2008. Sophomore Quarterback Reece Foy threw 5 touchdown passes in dominating Kaimuki with a final score of 49 to 14. Quarterback Foy completed 20 of 24 passes for 297 yards which is the most for a player in any state championship final or Oahu Prep Bowl since 1973. Coach Wendell will provide all the details of the game and talk about the performances of Scott Tang's fumble recovery, the double-flea flicker pass to Trevyn Tulonghari and the selection of Cody Petro-Sakuma as Co-defensive Player of the Year as selected by league coaches.

**Wes Nakama – Assistant Director of Information – Hawaii High School Athletic Association** – Wes will report on the 28th Annual Iolani Prep Classic which is featuring the nation's No. 1-ranked boys basketball team, Oak Hill Academy from Mouth of Wilson, Virginia. He will give us an update on the top high school prospects and the school each are considering. Maybe he can give us a clue on possible UH Warrior Football prospects? Also, Wes will talk about a new website, [scoringlive.com](http://scoringlive.com). that is available to the general public which reports the latest scores of all high school games in the state of Hawai'i founded in 2007. ScoringLive has developed from a football stats and scores resource for a select number of schools to becoming a comprehensive news, features, image, video and statistics resource for all high school sports in our state.
